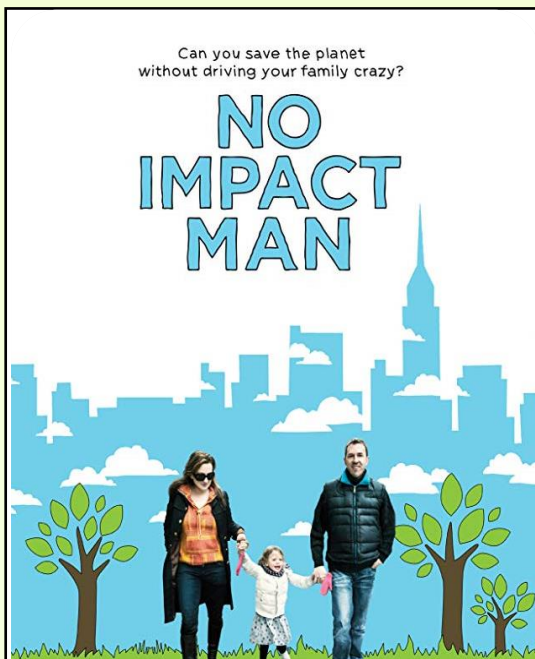

Whilst there is increasing worldwide concern about the inaction of governments to tackle Climate Change, people still take little ownership of their own personal carbon footprint. A common feeling is that there are bigger issues closer to home to deal with e.g. austerity, BREXIT etc. with feeling that “Climate change action – that’s someone else’s problem”

So, should we focus on living a low carbon lifestyle.... or get political and use our vote to demand that governments take more action?

To add to this debate, HoTT are screening a documentary about one man’s attempt to minimise his own carbon footprint, and how he fares.

**NO IMPACT MAN** is a 2009 documentary film of 90 minutes, following Colin Beavan and his family over one year as they try to live a low carbon lifestyle in New York City. The film captures the trials and tribulations of the whole family as Colin lives out his low carbon lifestyle.



*Film review - “No coffee, no elevators and no toilet paper — it's not easy trying to live a pre-industrial lifestyle for a year in Manhattan. It's even harder being the semi-supportive wife, which is what generates most of the electricity in this slight but entertaining documentary. However, it does draw attention to the high maintenance costs of our contemporary affluent Western lifestyle.”*

The film will be introduced by Nigel Peters who will talk about the challenges and share his personal experiences of reducing his carbon footprint in the Holme Valley.
